The Allan Cup

For the first time ever, a national championship is within grasp of Ontario Hockey Association "AA" clubs.

Effective for the 2024-25 season, OEHL members are eligible to compete for the Allan Cup, Canada's senior hockey championship.

Currently, the OEHL playoff champions are able to gain entry to the Allan Cup tournament by challenging (and defeating) the ACHL champion (or finalist if the champion is also host) in a best two-of-three playoff series.

This is part of a broader effort to restore the Allan Cup to its previous stature, with a vision of more provincial champions taking part in the tournament.


